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Instructions following treatment of a Perianal Abscess

- 1. Remove the dressing tonight or tomorrow morning.
- 2. Upon removal of the dressing, take a bath in warm water for 15 minutes. Continue to take warm baths twice a day for the next week.
- 3. Apply a cotton ball or gauze to the wound. You can expect a bloody, foul smelling discharge to continue for several days.
- 4. Keep bowels moving daily. Take a teaspoon of Metamucil (or equivalent fiber supplement) nightly to maintain soft stool.
- 5. Take pain medication, as needed, in accordance with the label or your prescription.
- 6. Continue to follow these instructions for 1 week.
- 7. Call our office if you have a fever, difficulty urinating or increasing pain.
- 8. Call the office to make a follow-up appointment for 1-2 weeks post treatment.
